Subject: Request for Independent Inquiry Regarding Non-Action by CMS Ahmedabad on Repeated Complaints Against CHI Shri Yagnesh Patel and HI Shri Hemang Trivedi, Non-Compliance of Railway Board Rotational Transfer Policy, and Continued Harassment of Contractor Staff

Respected Sir,

With due respect, we wish to bring to your kind notice that our organization has repeatedly submitted complaints, representations, and reminders regarding the conduct of CHI Shri Yagnesh Patel and HI Shri Hemang Trivedi, Ahmedabad Division, concerning arbitrary inspections, excessive penalties, harassment of workers, refusal of fair joint inspections, victimization of contractors, abuse of official position, and corrupt practices of CHI/HI.

Copies of the aforesaid complaints were also forwarded to the Chief Medical Superintendent (CMS), Ahmedabad Division, for necessary action. However, despite the seriousness of the allegations and repeated representations, no effective action, inquiry, or corrective measures have been initiated by the office of the CMS till date.

It is pertinent to note that both CHI Shri Yagnesh Patel and HI Shri Hemang Trivedi function under the administrative control and supervision of the CMS. Therefore, the complete absence of any inquiry, preventive action, or administrative intervention despite repeated complaints raises serious concerns regarding the manner in which these complaints have been dealt with.

It is further submitted that Railway Board Letter No. E(NG)I/2019/TR/10 dated 10.08.2023 clearly provides for rotational transfer of officials holding sensitive posts, particularly those dealing with contractors, inspections, certification, supervision, and public interaction. Clause 6.1 of the said circular specifically provides that railway employees holding sensitive posts and those frequently dealing with contractors/suppliers should be transferred out of their existing post/seat/station after



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completion of the prescribed tenure. The objective of the policy is to ensure transparency, prevent development of vested interests, and eliminate the possibility of misuse of official authority.

Despite specific references made by us in our previous complaints regarding the applicability of the above Railway Board circular, no action appears to have been taken for reviewing the continued posting of the concerned officials in sensitive positions. The prolonged continuation of such officials in posts directly connected with contractors and inspection activities, coupled with the complete absence of action on repeated complaints, raises a reasonable apprehension that the concerned officials may be receiving administrative protection, thereby enabling continuation of arbitrary actions, harassment of contractors, and possible unlawful practices.

It may be possible our Branch Officer had also independently submitted a written representation to the CMS regarding the conduct of the concerned officials, rotational transfer of officials holding sensitive posts and the difficulties being faced during execution of the contract. However, despite receipt of the said representation, no response, inquiry, or corrective action has been initiated by the CMS office till date. Such continued silence and inaction further strengthen the apprehension that the complaints are not being examined fairly and impartially.

It is further submitted that our organization has already provided video evidence clearly demonstrating the manner in which CHI Shri Yagnesh Patel and HI Shri Hemang Trivedi have been harassing, intimidating, and victimizing our staff during inspections and routine interactions. The submitted video recordings clearly reflect the hostile working environment being created by the concerned officials and substantiate the grievances repeatedly raised by our organization.

We also wish to bring to your kind notice that similar harassment, intimidation, undue pressure, and victimization are being carried out on a daily basis during the score card assessment process conducted by the concerned officials. Instead of objectively assessing the quality of work, the score card mechanism is allegedly being used as a tool to create pressure upon our workforce, demoralize employees, and artificially generate grounds for imposing excessive penalties. Workers are routinely subjected to threats, humiliation, and mental pressure during these score card evaluations, creating an atmosphere of fear and insecurity among the workforce.

As a direct consequence of such continuous harassment and intimidation, many workers are becoming demotivated and reluctant to attend duties. The resulting manpower shortages are thereafter cited as grounds for imposing further penalties upon our organization, thereby creating a vicious cycle of harassment, financial loss, and administrative victimization.

Despite submission of video evidence and repeated written complaints highlighting these issues, no corrective action has been initiated till date. The continued failure to address these documented instances of harassment further strengthens the apprehension that the concerned officials are being shielded from accountability, thereby enabling continuation of such arbitrary and unlawful practices.

We respectfully submit that when serious allegations are repeatedly brought to the notice of the competent supervisory authority and no action whatsoever is taken, it creates a perception that the concerned officials are being protected from accountability. Such circumstances adversely affect transparency, encourage misuse of authority, and undermine confidence in the grievance redressal mechanism.



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In view of the above, we humbly request your good office to:

1. Order an Independent Vigilance Inquiry into the conduct of CHI Shri Yagnesh Patel and HI Shri Hemang Trivedi.
2. Examine the reasons for non-action by the office of the CMS despite repeated complaints and representations given by our Branch officer.
3. Verify compliance with Railway Board Letter No. E(NG)I/2019/TR/10 dated 10.08.2023 regarding rotational transfer of officials holding sensitive posts.
4. Examine the video evidence already submitted by our organization and record statements of affected workers independently.
5. Preserve all CCTV footage, video recordings, inspection reports, score cards, correspondence, electronic communications, and other relevant records connected with this matter.
6. Restrict the concerned officials from inspecting, evaluating, grading, monitoring, scoring, or certifying our work until completion of an impartial inquiry.
7. Keep all disputed penalties under review until completion of the inquiry.
8. Appoint an independent third-party agency for transparent assessment and monitoring of contractual performance during the pendency of the inquiry.


The matter involves serious issues relating to administrative fairness, contractor victimization, misuse of official authority, and possible non-compliance with Railway Board instructions. We therefore request your immediate personal intervention in the interest of transparency, accountability, and justice.

Kindly treat this matter as **MOST URGENT AND TIME-BOUND**.

Subject: Final Reminder Regarding Harassment, Arbitrary Penalties, Corruption Concerns and Request for Immediate Independent Inquiry

Respected Sir,

With reference to our above-mentioned complaints and reminders, we regret to state that despite repeatedly bringing serious issues to the notice of the administration, no effective corrective action has yet been taken. The concerned officials continue to indulge in arbitrary inspections, biased grading, excessive penalties, intimidation of staff, and administrative harassment against our organisation.


It is extremely unfortunate that even after submission of detailed representations and supporting video evidence clearly showing harassment of our staff and refusal to conduct fair joint inspections, the situation remains unchanged. On the contrary, the actions of the concerned officials have further intensified, resulting in severe financial, operational, and reputational losses to our organisation.

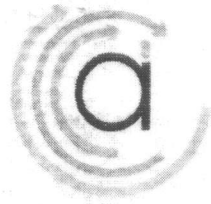
We once again submit that due to continuous pressure, threats, and intimidation during inspections, many workers are becoming demotivated and reluctant to attend duties, as they are being misled regarding continuation of the contract and payment of wages. Consequently, manpower shortages are being artificially created, and penalties for such shortages are thereafter unfairly imposed upon our firm by the same officials.

It is further submitted that due to continuous intimidation, pressure tactics, and unethical practices adopted during inspections, many workers are becoming demotivated and hesitant to attend duties, as they are being misled and threatened regarding the future continuation of the contract and payment of wages. Consequently, artificial manpower shortages are being created, following which penalties for shortage of manpower are unfairly imposed upon our firm by the very same officials. Such actions are seriously affecting smooth execution of contractual obligations and creating an atmosphere of fear, insecurity, and mental pressure among the workforce.

We respectfully state that our organization has already suffered penalties amounting to approximately more than Rs. 1 Crore in last 5 month due to arbitrary and biased actions of the concerned officials.

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The continued pattern of unilateral assessments, refusal of transparent joint verification, excessive penalties, and targeted victimization raises serious concerns regarding misuse of authority, mala fide intention, and possible corrupt practices.

Further, as per Railway Board Letter No. E(NG)I/2019/TR/10 dated 10/08/2023 regarding transfer of officials holding sensitive posts, the concerned officials appear to have remained posted at Ahmedabad Station beyond the prescribed period despite directly dealing with contractors, inspections, and certification work.

In view of the seriousness of the matter, we once again strongly request the administration to immediately:

1. Initiate an independent Vigilance Inquiry against the concerned officials.
2. Transfer/rotate the concerned officials as per Railway Board policy.
3. Keep all disputed penalties under review till completion of inquiry.
4. Appoint an independent third-party agency for transparent monitoring and evaluation.
5. Restrict the concerned officials from evaluating, inspecting, grading, monitoring, or certifying our work till completion of inquiry.

Despite repeated complaints, no preventive action has been initiated till date, which is causing continuous prejudice and irreparable financial losses to our organization. We therefore request your immediate personal intervention in the matter before the situation escalates further.

Kindly treat this matter as **MOST URGENT AND TIME-BOUND**.

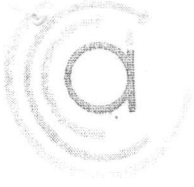

Subject: Urgent Reminder Regarding Harassment, Arbitrary Penalties, Corruption Concerns and Request for Independent Inquiry

Reference: Our Complaints dated 26/03/2026 and 30/03/2026

Respected Sir,

With reference to **our complaints dated 26/03/2026 and 30/03/2026 regarding the conduct of CHI Shri Yagnesh Patel and HI Shri Hemang Trivedi** at Ahmedabad Railway Station, we regret to state that no effective corrective action has been taken till date. Instead, after submission of our complaints, harassment, victimisation, intimidation, and administrative pressure upon our firm and workforce have further increased.

The concerned officials are **continuously imposing arbitrary and excessive penalties, threatening and pressurising our staff during inspections, due to which workers are leaving their jobs, and creating an atmosphere of fear and intimidation with apparent intent to financially harass our organisation and create grounds for termination of our contract.** Such conduct is seriously affecting smooth execution of contractual work and causing severe mental pressure upon our workforce.


We are also submitting video evidence clearly showing harassment of our staff and the refusal of the concerned officials to conduct fair, transparent, and impartial joint inspections whenever objections are raised by our representatives. Despite repeated requests, proper joint verification is being denied, resulting in unilateral and biased assessments.

The continuous misuse of authority, arbitrary penalties, refusal of transparent inspections, biased grading, and administrative victimisation raise serious concerns regarding abuse of official position and possible corrupt practices.

Further, as per Railway Board Letter No. E(NG)I/2019/TR/10 dated 10/08/2023, Clause 6.1 clearly states:

“Railway employees holding sensitive posts, including those who frequently come into contact with public and/or contractors/suppliers, are required to be transferred out of their existing post/seat or station after four years.”

In this case, both the above-mentioned officials have reportedly remained posted at Ahmedabad Station for more than four years despite holding sensitive positions directly connected with contractors and inspections, which appears to be in violation of the above Railway Board guidelines.

In view of the serious allegations, evident bias, and ongoing victimisation, we hereby strongly request that, till completion of an impartial inquiry, the concerned officials must immediately be restrained from evaluating, inspecting, grading, monitoring, certifying, or assessing our work in any manner whatsoever, as their biased evaluations are directly resulting in arbitrary penalties, financial loss, contractual prejudice, and continued harassment to our organisation.

Accordingly, we request the following immediate actions:

1. Immediate Vigilance Inquiry against the concerned officials.
2. Immediate transfer/rotation of the concerned officials as per Railway Board policy.
3. Suspension/review of arbitrary penalties imposed during the disputed period till completion of inquiry.
4. Appointment of an independent third-party auditor for transparent evaluation and monitoring as per tender conditions.
5. Immediate restriction upon the concerned officials from evaluating, inspecting, grading, monitoring, or assessing our work till completion of inquiry.

We respectfully submit that failure to take immediate corrective action shall compel us to approach higher authorities including Railway Vigilance, Railway Board, Central Vigilance Commission (CVC), CBI, and appropriate judicial forums for protection of our legal and contractual rights, at the sole risk, cost, and responsibility of the administration.

This matter may kindly be treated as MOST URGENT.

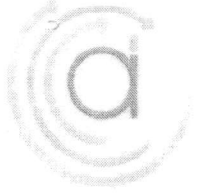

Subject: Request for Immediate Action on Complaint Against CHI Shri Yagnesh Patel and HI Shri Hemang Trivedi

Respected Sir,

With reference to our above-mentioned letter, we would like to reiterate and strongly emphasize the serious issues already brought to your notice regarding the alleged corrupt practices and misconduct by **CHI Shri Yagnesh Patel** and **HI Shri Hemang Trivedi**.

Despite submitting a formal complaint, we regret to state that **no action or acknowledgment has been received from your office till date**. Meanwhile, both officials are continuously pressurizing their subordinates to impose penalties on us arbitrarily, irrespective of whether the work has been executed satisfactorily as per contract conditions. This is causing undue harassment and continuous financial loss to our organization.

Further, as per **Railway Board Letter No. E(NG)I/2019/TR/10 dated 10/08/2023**, Clause 6.1 clearly states:

"Railway employees holding sensitive posts, including those who frequently come into contact with public and/or contractors/suppliers, are required to be transferred out of their existing post/seat or station after four years."

In the present case, both the above-mentioned officials have been posted at **Ahmedabad station for more than 4 years**, which is in clear violation of the above-mentioned Railway Board guidelines. Additionally, Clause **6.2 (F)(7)** also categorizes such positions as **sensitive posts**, further strengthening the requirement for their rotation/transfer.

In view of the above, we once again earnestly request your good office to:

1. Acknowledge our complaint formally

Subject: Urgent representation regarding alleged corruption, criminal intimidation, deliberate imposition of excessive penalties, threat of termination of contract and administrative victimisation at Ahmedabad Railway Station

Respected Sir,

We are constrained to submit the present representation under circumstances of extreme pressure, fear and mental distress arising out of continuous harassment, intimidation and alleged misuse of official authority by **CHI Shri Yagnesh Patel and HI Shri Himag Trivedi** at Ahmedabad Railway Station.

It is respectfully submitted that the above officials have allegedly been **pressurising our firm for illegal gratification** and have **threatened that in case of non-compliance, maximum penalties would be imposed, adverse performance records would be created and our contract would ultimately be terminated.**

Subsequent to our firm's refusal to entertain any unlawful demands, the concerned officials have allegedly **started deliberately targeting our contractual work during inspections**, imposing disproportionate and unjustified penalties and creating an atmosphere of coercion and financial pressure with an apparent intention either to force submission or to artificially build grounds for termination of the contract.

It is further submitted that this issue was **verbally and informally brought to the notice of senior railway officers, including the Sr. Divisional Mechanical Engineer, on multiple occasions.** However, in the absence of documentary evidence at that stage, no effective corrective action appears to have been initiated.

We also wish to submit that **in an earlier instance, our firm had raised a complaint against another CHI official regarding imposition of heavy and unjustified penalties.** Upon review by higher railway authorities, the said penalties were **found to be incorrect and were subsequently withdrawn / rectified.** This establishes that our grievances have merit and deserve fair and objective consideration even where immediate documentary evidence may not be readily available.

It is also pertinent to highlight that **if the performance of our firm was genuinely poor, the same should have been reflected through a substantial number of passenger complaints on official grievance platforms such as Rail Madad.** However, it is surprising to note that complaints against our work on Rail Madad have been **minimal and not proportionate to the heavy penalties being imposed,** thereby raising serious concerns regarding the fairness and objectivity of the inspection and penalty mechanism.

We further wish to bring to your kind notice that **a similar pattern of penalty pressure and harassment was reportedly faced by the previous contractor at Ahmedabad Railway Station, M/s Ruchita Hospitality, whose contract was ultimately terminated.** We have reasonable apprehension that the same

officials were associated with the inspection and penalty process during that period as well, indicating a possible repeated misuse of official authority and administrative victimisation of contractors.

It is also submitted that **CHI Shri Yagnesh Patel has been continuously posted at Ahmedabad Railway Station for more than a decade**, which appears inconsistent with the spirit of the **rotational transfer policy issued by Railway Board**. Such prolonged posting at a sensitive location may lead to development of undue influence over inspection processes and penalty administration, thereby creating an unhealthy and coercive working environment.

Additionally, our workforce is frequently subjected to **mental harassment, intimidation and undue pressure during inspections**, adversely affecting their morale and attendance. This situation is subsequently cited as justification for **imposition of heavy manpower penalties**, resulting in severe financial loss and operational instability for our organisation.

If established, such actions may amount to serious misconduct including:

- Criminal intimidation and coercive pressure for illegal gratification
- Deliberate and excessive imposition of penalties
- Abuse and misuse of official authority
- Attempt to create artificial grounds for termination of contractual work
- Administrative victimisation of contractor
- Creation of hostile working environment
- Violation of principles of natural justice and fair administrative practice

In view of the gravity of the matter, we most humbly request your good office to **order an immediate impartial high-level vigilance inquiry** into the conduct of the concerned officials and to ensure that our contractual work is allowed to continue in a fair, transparent and pressure-free manner.

It is submitted with deep regret that if the present situation continues and no corrective intervention is made we may be **compelled to surrender the contract and discontinue work with effect from 31/03/2026**, as functioning under continuous threat, coercion and financial pressure has become extremely difficult.

We also reserve our right to approach **higher railway authorities, Railway Vigilance, Railway Board and other competent legal forums** for protection of our contractual and legal rights.

We trust that urgent and appropriate action will be taken in the interest of justice, transparency and administrative integrity.
